Our KLC Papyrus fabric is finally being produced in wallpaper form! We couldn't be more thrilled to add this to our collection and can't wait to see these patterns blossom on the walls of your next project.

Our most popular design, Papyrus takes inspiration from the marshy scenery depicted in a wall painting from the West Bank of Thebes (c.1390 B.C.), now in the British Museum, London, while the bold, geometric repeat of the pattern was influenced by the iconic, floral patterns of William Morris' textiles from the 1800s. Nothing makes Katie happier than to see old things made new again.
